




PARTNER REFERRALS

REPORTED VIOLENCE AND ITS TYPES







*Violence against women (VAW) is collectively, violent acts that are primarily or exclusively committed against women and girls. This includes all the cases outside Domestic Violence.



TREND OF CALLS









DISAGGREGATION BY SEX AND AGE







DISAGGREGATION BY CIVIL STATUS AND EDUCATIONAL LEVEL
